8. Examine the role of the Berbers in the spread of Islam in West Africa (25 marks)
9. "The reasons for the outbreak of the 19th century jihads were more political than religious". Discuss (25 marks)
- 10a). Explain the reasons for the extensive fighting between Mandika state and the French in the late 19th century. (15 marks)
- b). Why the Mandika finally defeated? (10 marks)
11. Discuss the factors that facilitated the spread of Islam in the ancient empire of Ghana. (25 marks)
12. Assess the contribution of Askia Muhammad Toure to the growth and development of Islam in the empire of Songhai. (25 marks)
