Tracy: Oh! That's awesome. Let me wish you a safe journey to Butabi village. Send my regards to them when you reach there.

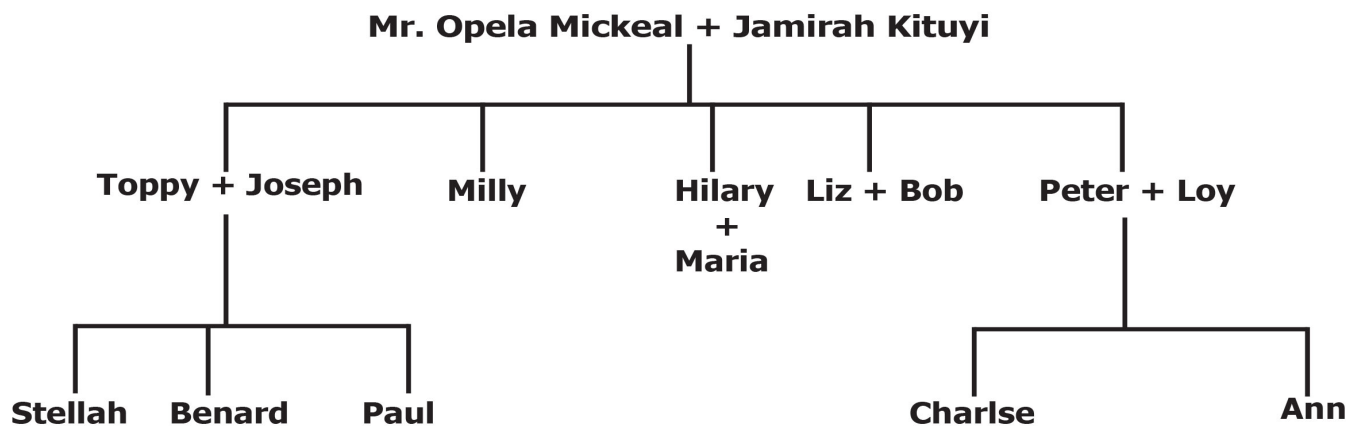
