Item 1:

Map Skills

Use the East Africa 1:50,000 (UGANDA) Nakasongola map extract, sheet 50/2, edition 1-USD to respond to the tasks.

Nakasongola is a district found in the heart of Uganda. The area is generally flat with a few uplands (hills). It experiences a long dry season and a short-wet season. It is mainly covered by scrub vegetation, dotted with a few thickets and woodlands. Your teacher conducted a study tour for your class to visit and understand the geography of Nakasongola.

Tasks:

- a)** If Okello is to travel along the bound surface road from Muuma (grid reference 340430 to Nakasongola (grid reference 405459):
- Measure the distance he will travel and state your answer in kilometers.
 - If the boda-boda charges 1,725/= per kilometer, how much money will he spend on the journey.
- b)** Okello wants to obtain Walukoge seasonal swamp from the local community to set up fish ponds but lacks knowledge on the size of the swamp. Help Okello determine the area covered by Walukoge seasonal swamp.

- c) A group of tourists climbed Sungira hill and reached its peak at trigonometrical station (Primary). They got thirsty and were looking for water to drink.

Task

Help Direct the tourists to locate the borehole close to the Sub County headquarters.

Item 2: Photograph Skills

A senior one learner conducted field work study around her local area, observed various features and took several photographs to help her understand the geography of the local area, interviewed the residents around to find out some of the challenges they face in the area.
