Item 1

Kabulubulu is a town in a valley along Kampala-Busabala road blessed with streams and swamps like Koliddidu swamp. Unfortunately, due to the increasing population in the area, people have started encroaching on the swamps to obtain land for crop growing to earn a living and also sustain their livelihoods. Recently the heavy prolonged rains received in the area resulted into destructive floods which destroyed people's homesteads, farmlands and properties. Some people living in the area would like to migrate from the above area but have nowhere to go. The local people and leaders have organised a sensitisation meeting to handle the above situation.

Task

- Explain the possible causes of the natural calamity in the above area.
- What advice would you give to help the people in the area to handle the above conditions.

Item 2

For this item, use the East Africa 1: 50,000 (Uganda) map extract of Lukaya series 73/2, sheet 45/3, Edition H-USD, and the information in the text below and the support materials to solve the tasks given.

- a) There is growing of rice between the forest near Sabawaali and Luwera and rice growers in the region are planning to expand their farms into the forest. The government wants to establish the size of the forest in KM\$^2\$ in order to fence and protect it.

- b) A group of migrants have recently settled in the area but are finding it hard to understand the economic activities they can conduct in the area. You have been contacted to guide the migrants.

Task

- i. What message will you deliver to the migrants.
- ii. What are the likely challenges the migrants will face in the area?
