SECTION A

1. Assess the role of circumcision ceremonies in the social and economic set up of any **one** pre-colonial society in East Africa. (25 marks)
2. Account for the formation and expansion of pre-colonial states in the interior of East Africa by the 19th century. (25 marks)
3. Examine the impact of slave trade on the peoples of East Africa during the 19th century. (25 marks)

SECTION B

4. To what extent did Mirambo contribute to the development of the long distance trade during the 19th century? (25 marks)
5. Examine the impact of the scramble and partition of East African countries during the colonial period. (25 marks)
6. “The land question was responsible for the Mau – Mau rebellion in Kenya.” Discuss. (25 marks)
7. Account for the factors that led to the failure of Uganda to become a settler colony. (25 marks)

8. Examine the impact of *Ujamaa* policy on the social and economic development of Tanzania since independence. (25 marks)
9. Analyze the measures taken to fight neocolonialism in any **one** East African country since independence. (25 marks)
10. Discuss factors that led to the revival of the East African community. (25 marks)
