SECTION A

Answer all items in this Section.

Item 1

KICO is a primary school in Kisenyi zone. Currently they process learners' report cards manually; where subject teachers fill mark scores in a printed report book, after which the class teacher computes the total, average and comments about each learner. Many times parents have raised concerns about errors made in the reports. In one of the parents' meeting, one new parent suggested that a computerized report system be adopted. The idea was welcomed by the school administration and a flyer bearing ICT tools was sent to them as shown below.



Given limited knowledge on the ICT tools displayed on the flyer, management failed to select which ICTs would be appropriate for the report system.

Task

- (a) Guide the school management to select the appropriate ICT tools that will help the school to produce accurate report cards.
- (b) Hardware, Software and Data in such a system are valuable. Enlighten the school administration about possible threats they may face and advise them on the precautions that can be taken.


