“Whichever one of you has committed no sin may throw the first stone at her”. ⁸Then he bent over again and wrote on the ground. ⁹When they heard this, they all left, one by one, the older ones first. Jesus was left alone, with the woman still standing there. ¹⁰he straightened up and said to her, “Where are they? Is there no one left to condemn you?” ¹¹“No one, sir.” She answered.
